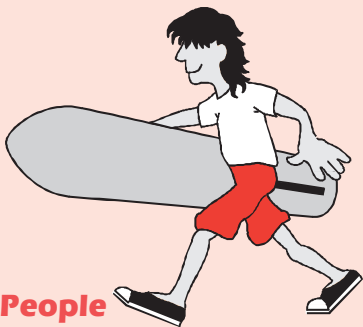

I must have more wealth.*



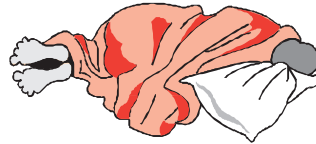
### Middle Aged

hearts get harder yet.*



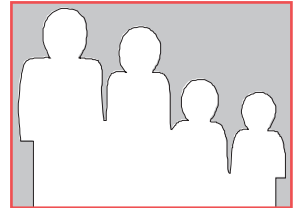
### The Dying
